The July 2020 FFO lists over 100 funding opportunities for research, evaluation, and dissemination, including multiple highlighted funding opportunities.

(1) NIH: Promoting Research on Music and Health: Phased Innovation Award for Music Interventions.

The purpose of this Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) is to promote innovative research on music and health with an emphasis on developing music interventions aimed at understanding their mechanisms of action and clinical applications for the treatment of many diseases, disorders, and conditions. Applications are due by October 2, 2020.

(2) NIH: Ruth L. Kirschstein National Research Service Award (NRSA) Individual Predoctoral Fellowship

to Promote Diversity in Health-Related Research. The purpose of this award is to enhance the diversity of the health-related research workforce by supporting the research training of predoctoral students from diverse backgrounds including those from groups that are underrepresented in the biomedical, behavioral, or clinical research workforce. Applications are due by August 8, 2020.

(3) **NIH: Ruth L. Kirschstein National Research Service Award (NRSA) Individual Senior Fellowship**. The National Institutes of Health (NIH) awards senior individual research training fellowships to experienced scientists who wish to make major changes in the direction of their research careers or who wish to broaden their scientific background by acquiring new research capabilities as independent investigators in research fields relevant to the missions of participating NIH Institutes and Centers. Applications are due by August 8, 2020.
