

The 2023 SRCD Biennial Meeting Location

The Governing Council and the 2023 conference program co-chairs, Gigi Luk (McGill University) and Rashmita Mistry (University of California, Los Angeles), are deeply concerned about holding the biennial meeting in a state that limits an individual's right to choose

Last Friday, the Supreme Court's decision to overturn *Roe v. Wade* gave states the power to regulate abortions and Utah swiftly put their "trigger law" into effect, effectively banning abortions except in limited circumstances. As many know, the [SRCD 2023 Biennial meeting](#) is scheduled for March 23-25 in Salt Lake City, Utah.

SRCD biennial meetings typically draw about 6,000 attendees. The dates, locations, and venues for the meetings are chosen more than five years in advance, [with several factors in mind](#).
